Geographical analyses

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Introduction

These tables show details of finalised 2005-06 Child and Working Tax Credit awards to families in each country of the UK, in each region of England, in each local authority (county, district and unitary authority) and in each Westminster and Scottish Parliament constituency. They show the numbers of awards, the numbers underpaid and overpaid at 5 April 2006, and the aggregate amounts of underpayments and overpayments.

The tables are consistent with the figures for the United Kingdom shown in "Child and Working Tax Credits Statistics Finalised annual awards 2005-06. Supplement on payments in 2005-06", which contains details of the sources and definitions of the figures.

Geographical allocation

To produce these table, each tax credit award has been allocated to a local authority district, and to a constituency, based on the address of the claimant(s) - where possible, that held in the Child Benefit administrative system at August 2005.

For awards with positive finalised entitlements at any time in 2005-06 the allocations are as described in "Child and Working Tax Credits Statistics Finalised annual awards. 2005-06. Geographical analyses."

The tables in this supplement also cover terminated awards, awards tapered to zero and other awards with no entitlement in 2005-06. The geographical allocation of these awards has been by the same method.
